












WOMENS WARD VERANDAH




HEIGHT OF ROOF WHERE IT ATTACHES TO THE MAIN BUILDING




ELEVATION OF WOMANS WARD









EXISTING ROOF PLAN



'NEW' ROOF PLAN







CAFE

- 7. CAFE SEEMS TO HAVE TOO MANY ROOMS, WHILE THERE ARE NOT MANY SMALL HIRE OR LEASE SPACES. PRESUME THAT IS JUST A MATTER OF FITTING OUT IF CAFE OPERATOR DOESN'T WANT TO USE A ROOM, THEN IT IS AVAILABLE FOR HIRE/LEASE.
- 8. TOO MANY/TOO FEW TOILETS, E.G. COMPARED WITH LOCAL SHOPPING MALL. THINK THERE MAY BE MORE TOILETS IN THE MALL THEN FIRST APPEARS. AND MALL HAS MAINLY SHORT TERM VISITORS, WHILE OBH MAY HAVE PEOPLE THERE FOR SEVERAL HOURS. AND THE BCA WILL DETERMINE WHAT IS REQUIRED.
